

WHAT TO CONSIDER WHEN WRITING UP YOUR WILL

Do you know the cost of drafting up a Will? During National Wills Week there are a number of attorneys who will assist you free of charge.

2

Make sure it is valid by having your Will in writing, signed by yourself and two witnesses (these witnesses can't be beneficiaries of the Will).

3

Cover all of your assets in the Will. Care must be taken in cases where the asset has more than one owner.

4

If you have children, who will be their legal guardian? Should you not appoint one, the state will appoint one on your behalf.

5

Do you have somewhere safe to keep your Will? It should be in a safe or vault and your executors should know its whereabouts.
